

Smoke Alarm Test Record Chart

The battery in a smoke alarm should be replaced annually.

Place an asterisk in the appropriate box in the chart to show the month in which the battery is due for renewal.

The alarm should be tested *regularly* once a week.

Tick the appropriate box in the chart when you do your weekly test.

Vacuum inside the alarm casing once or twice a year.

	January					Have an annual home fire drill, with everyone following your Home Escape Plan.
	February					Don't overfill chip pans, or leave them unattended.
	March					Don't smoke in bed.
	April					Protect your children from fire hazards.
	May					Shut all doors and switch off electrical appliances before going to bed.
	June					Keep children away from barbecues.
	July					Fully extinguish cigarettes and bonfires when in the countryside.
	August					Take fire escape precautions when on holiday.
	September					Keep matches and lighters away from children and teach them fire safety awareness.
	October					Get your electric blankets safety checked and serviced.
	November					Never carry fireworks and don't return to unexploded ones.
	December					Never leave lit candles unattended and make sure they are stable.

REMEMBER

Fit smoke alarms.

Test them each week.

Replace the batteries once a year.
