What we're going to do to help reduce our local risks

Responding to incidents	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Crews will aim to achieve 100% WA competence in order to provide an effective team to respond to operational incidents.• All crews will visit SSRI sites on their station ground.• The station will plan and implement one station three pump group exercise.
Fires in the home	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will target Safe & Well visits to identified priority one and other referrals, utilising wholetime/RDS personnel from Alton Fire Station and the wider Havant Group.• We will attend four local events to raise awareness of fire safety in the home, in line with local and national safety campaigns.
Safer road users	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Delivery of two road safety initiatives to young people at Alton College. This initiative will be targeted, programmed, advised and delivered in conjunction with the Community Safety team.• Utilising the CTCG parish contacts, we will generate referrals to run a pilot aimed to deliver road safety to the over 65's.
Community safety working with partners	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will work to identify potential risks to the community through the completion of a minimum of four Environmental Visual Audits (EVA's). Our aim is to work with PCSO's to identify risk and resolve potential issues with the assistance of EHDC before incidents occur.• Work with our own Community Safety department to reduce the number of false alarms.
Local resilience work Building upon community engagement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assist in the organising and development of local resilience plans within the local parish council.• Continued monthly meeting with the CTCG will assist in targeting need within our communities.
