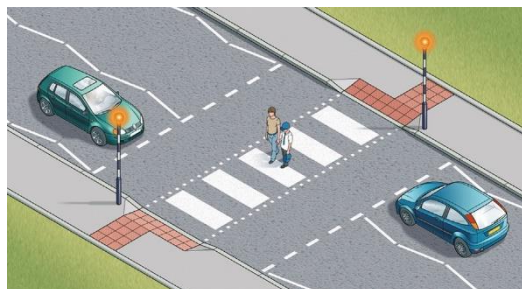


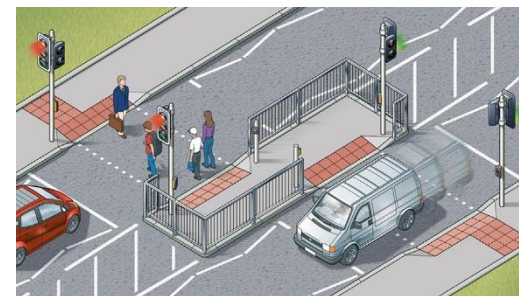


Can you match the crossings with their descriptions?

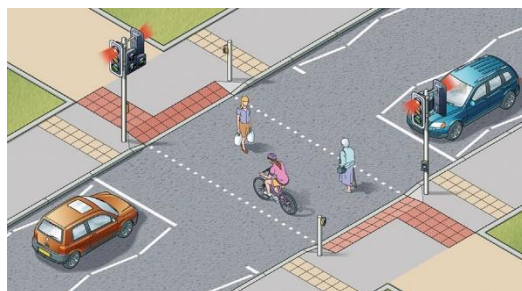
Draw lines to match the crossings with their descriptions!



Toucan crossings are light-controlled crossings which allow cyclists and pedestrians to share crossing space and cross at the same time. They are push-button operated. Pedestrians and cyclists will see the green signal together.



Equestrian crossings are for horse riders. They have pavement barriers, wider crossing spaces, horse and rider figures in the light panels and either two sets of controls (one higher), or just one higher control panel.



Zebra crossings gives priority to pedestrians. Meaning cars need to slow down and stop if there is anyone waiting to cross.

'Staggered' pelican or puffin crossings. When the crossings on each side of the island are not in line they are two separate crossings. On reaching the central island, press the button again and wait for a steady green figure.
