We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 14 May 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

You asked:

How many tests have been carried out within HIWFRS for each of the last three years (2021, 2022, 2023) in both the "with cause" and "post-accident" categories?

Our answer:

We can confirm that we hold the information requested. However, due to the low number of tests performed, releasing this information would enable the identification of individuals. As this would be unfair, within the meaning of the UK GDPR, to do in response to your request, we are refusing to provide this data per Section 40 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
