Incident Type:	S1.2.3 Person Collapsed (Gain entry / access)
Descriptor:	Calls to assist another agency gain access to a patient to allow them to treat the individual where a delay would cause a medical emergency
Planning Assumption	Assist Ambulance gain entry for a casualty collapsed behind the front door.

1.	Incident command, information gathering, dynamic risk assessment, crew briefing, liaison, assist with task 5	1 x ICS L1
2.	Establish and maintain cordon	1 x FF
3.	Assessment of property / means of entry (Reconnaissance)	1 x FF
4.	Internal inspection of premises	2 x FF
5.	Provision of ladder to assist gaining entry from upper floors	3 x FF
6.	Command Support	1 x FF
7.	Provision of lighting	2 x FF
8.	Provision of breaking in gear / small gear	1 x FF
9.	Make up of equipment	All
10.	IRS / Investigation details	1 x ICS L1
11.	Debrief	All
