We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 14 December 2022. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

You asked:

Statistics on the number of fires your fire service has attended at recycling centres, scrapyards, landfills, and any other waste management facilities since 1st January 2022. If possible, please also highlight any incidents where other regional fire services have been brought in to assist in putting out these fires - this is not completely necessary, but will help us to build a more accurate picture of this year's waste fire incidents.

Our answer:

We can confirm we hold the information requested. Between 1 January 2022 and 19 December 2022, there have been a total of 14 incidents recorded at recycling centres, scrapyards, landfills, and any other waste management facilities. Of those, one had resources from another Fire Service, this being Surrey.
