We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 5 January 2023. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

We can confirm we hold the information requested.

- Please can you confirm who your Head of Transport is and provide name and contact details including email address.

The Head of Operational Assets can be contacted via Fleet.Management@hantsfire.gov.uk. We are refusing to provide the name and other contact details of the individual as it would be unfair to do, within the meaning of the UK GDPR. As such we are refusing to provide this information as per section 40 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

- Can you share your fleet list, detailing make and model of assets?

Fleet list attached. We have also included a sheet that shows the abbreviations of the vehicles.

- Please can you confirm who is your breakdown provider (2022)?

For our light fleet, covering our vehicles under 7.5 tons such as our recovery vans, the breakdown provider is RAC. For our vehicles over 7.5 tons, for example our rescue pumps (known as our heavy fleet), we use the best availability recovery service at the time they need to be rescued.

- Can you please confirm how your vehicles are serviced e.g. whether you have your own workshops/ use council workshops?

Our vehicles are serviced in our own maintenance facilities.

- Please confirm the total number of workshops and technicians you have that service your vehicle fleet?

We have 22 technicians and two workshops.

- Please can you confirm your annual spend on service, maintenance (2021-2022)?

The annual planned and unplanned maintenance for the service in 2021-2022 was £814,322.

- Please can you confirm your annual spend on damage repair (2021-2022)?

The annual spend on damage repair in 2021-2022 was £11,784.
