We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 2 January 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

You asked:

We wish to understand if there have ever been any issues with accessing Mount Lane by the Fire Service. So our question is - by reviewing all Fire Service reporting related to Mount Lane, Lockerley and specifically, but not limited to, SO51 0XX, has there been any observations, concerns or indications made by the Service about restricted or limited access for Fire Service vehicles that might indicate increased response time when dealing with an emergency on Mount Lane? Perhaps with a time limit of the last 5 years - so 02 Jan 2019 to 02 Jan 2024.

Our answer:

Hampshire and Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service has no record of any concern about restricted or limited access to Mount land between 2 January 2019 and 2 January 2024. We have also contacted the local station and they are not aware of, or have, any concerns. As such this information is not held as per Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
