We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 18 January 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

You asked:

Please can you provide any photographs of the fire at Bradley Cottages, Basingstoke Road/or A33, Micheldever, Winchester, XXX in 2003.

If you also have the fire report for the incident, please can you provide that also.

Our answer:

Having contacted the appropriate teams, we can confirm that Hampshire and Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service does not hold, per Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, any of the information requested above. This is because we normally only retain information about the incidents we attend for seven years.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
