## Freedom of Information Act 2000

Dear ██████████

We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 24 January 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

### ***You asked:***

*Under the Freedom of Information Act, I would like to request the following information:*

- 1. How many vehicles do you have across the whole fleet (please provide data for the past 3 years)?*
- 2. Please break down vehicles in Q1 by vehicle type (i.e. make / model)*
- 3. Please break down vehicles in Q1 by fuel type (i.e. petrol / diesel / hybrid / full electric)*
- 4. How much do you spend annually on refuelling costs for vehicles in Q1 (please provide data for the past 3 years)?*
- 5. What is the average annual mileage per vehicle for vehicles in Q1?*
- 6. Do you have (and if yes, how many) electric vehicle chargers at your vehicle fleet base/HQ?*

### **Our answer:**

We can confirm that we hold the information requested, apart from the average annual mileage for all our vehicles. This is because some of our vehicles do not have the ability to track mileage (such as trailers) and other vehicles that have not been in our fleet for over a year so unable to calculate an average. Additionally, there are some vehicles while on the fleet list, have not been put into use. Therefore, they have not accrued any mileage.

Please find the information we do hold in the attached documents. We have also included an abbreviation guide to explain the acronyms used in our fleet list.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
