We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 25 January 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

You asked:

We are looking for any petroleum officer records that you have for St James' Hospital. It is known to have held a Petroleum Licence between 1939 and 1966 for 500 gallons (licence number 623).

Our answer:

Hampshire and Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service do not hold any historic records regarding a Petroleum license for St James' Hospital. Consequently, this information is not held as per Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

We can only recommend that you contact Portsmouth City Council who are the primary authority for this type of record.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
