We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 29 January 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

You asked:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act to obtain the total number of call outs for each fire station on the Isle of Wight for each month throughout 2022 (1st January 2022 to 31st December 2022 inclusive).

Please split this into Wholetime and Retained and break down the information by station and by month. Please also include the availability/unavailability for each station on each month throughout 2022.

For clarity, in respect of the breakdown of incidents, I kindly request the total number of shouts for each station on a month-by-month basis, which of course then gives the yearly total for each station. When I say splitting wholetime and retained, I mean give the breakdown for the station in terms of wholetime shouts and retained shouts (applicable for Newport and Ryde only). For example: Newport may have gone on 400 shouts in 2021, with Newport retained turning out an additional 50 times - I require this information broken down as the example, not just a total figure of 450.

Our answer:

We can confirm we hold the information requested, please find it attached.

We have split the data up by WDS (Wholetime Duty System), RDS (Retained Duty System) and Day. Ryde station is wholetime during the day and is retained for the rest of the time.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
