You asked:

4. What is the authority's projected spending on fuel costs for authority vehicles for the financial year 2023/24?

Our answer:

£900,000.00. Please be aware that this projected fuel spend is higher than previous years as we have considered various external factors i.e. the war in Ukraine, the rising fuel prices etc with the aim of avoiding an overspend at the end of the financial year.
