We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 21 October 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

***You asked:***

*Grenfell second phase report, have Hampshire fire and rescue changed anything in their policies since this has been released with regards to what has been recommended*

**Our answer:**

Hampshire and Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service (HIWFRS) acknowledge that the Grenfell Tower Phase two report is an extremely important report which includes vital learning for individuals and organisations. Many of the 58 recommendations apply to central and local government, building regulators, building owners, the NFCC and London Fire Brigade. HIWFRS are currently reviewing the recommendations to understand what impact any of them may have on HIWFRS. Once the review has taken place, we will progress any which are identified to have a direct impact on the work HIWFRS deliver to make communities safer. As this review is ongoing, we have not yet made any changes to our policies or procedures since the report has been released.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
