We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 21 November 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested and hold the data unless noted below. Please find our answers in red.

You asked:

I would be grateful if you could provide responses to the following questions:

1. *How many motor vehicles are owned by the service as of November 2024?* **467**
2. *How many electric vehicles (including hybrid) are owned by the service as of November 2024?* **48 Electric and 24 Hybrid.**
3. *The manufacturer name of electric vehicles bought by the service up to November 2024?* **TOYOTA, VAUXHALL, SKODA, PEUGEOT, NISSAN, KIA**
4. *How much has your service spent on electric vehicles up to November 2024?* **£1,258,565.65**
5. *What are electric vehicles used for in your service?* **General duties across the Service including within the pool fleet. We have also started to use electric vehicles as officer response vehicles.**
6. *How many electric vehicles does the service plan to purchase in the five-year period to March 2030?* **Hampshire and Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service does not hold this**

information as it is unknown at this stage and will depend on budgets set. Therefore, we are unable to provide you with this as per Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

7. *What budget has your service allocated to purchase electric vehicles every year up to March 2030?* Hampshire and Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service does not hold this information as it is unknown at this stage. Therefore, we are unable to provide you with this as per Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
