We are writing in respect of your application for the release of information held by the Service, which we received on 17 December 2024. We can confirm that we have now completed our search for the information requested.

You asked:

Please provide any documents related to the provision of casualty care kits on operational vehicles and any other first aid kits. I am interested in whether tamper seal tags are fitted, post user check procedure and inspection regimes.

Our answer:

We can confirm that we hold the information requested. Please find attached "IEC-Co-Ro Equipment Inventory" this document lists the items contained within our kits and maintenance checks to be performed. IEC kits are provided on frontline fire appliances and 'special' vehicles such as Co-Responder (Co-Ro) vehicles.

Other vehicles and our buildings have standard off the shelf first aid kits. There is no mandatory list of items that are required in the first aid kit if the contents are suitable and appropriate to the needs of the workplace, this is dependent on the outcome of the first aid needs risk assessment. First aid kits are to be checked monthly and these checks recorded.

As an organisation, we have different first aid capabilities depending on the role and location of the first aid kit.

We can confirm that we do not use tamper seal tags or tags of any sort on our first aid kits.

The above concludes our investigation into this matter.
