- 4 Any local government elector on application to the Chief Finance Officer to Hampshire and Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Authority (who can be contacted by post at The Castle, Winchester, SO23 8UB or by email to [budget@hants.gov.uk](mailto:budget@hants.gov.uk)) may by appointment visit Hampshire County Council's main office in Winchester on weekdays (excluding bank holidays) between 10am and 4pm to inspect and make copies of these documents.
- 5 Paper copies of the documents can be supplied to any local government elector at the elector's request on payment of a reasonable sum for each copy.
- 6 The audit certificate is not yet available to publish, as stated within the auditor's report. EY (our auditor) cannot formally conclude the audit and issue an audit certificate until the National Audit Office, as group auditor, has confirmed that no further assurances will be required from EY as component auditors of Hampshire and Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Authority. The audit certificate will be published when received.
